Susan is a Certified Professional in Healthcare Quality (CPHQ) and is also a Fellow of the National Association for Healthcare Quality.

CPHQ: Certified Professional in Healthcare Quality

What is it? A voluntary certification that recognizes professional and academic achievement by individuals in the field of healthcare quality management.

The HQCB web site states: "The CPHQ designation means you are a **WORLD CLASS, CERTIFIED, PROFESSIONAL**. It is the worldwide Gold Standard for the healthcare quality professional. Certified Healthcare Quality Professionals are committed to excellence in healthcare quality."

Who is eligible for this certification?

No minimum education and experience are required to take the CPHQ examination so anyone may apply. If interested, it is recommended by the Healthcare Quality Certification Board (HQCB) that each person considering this achievement take time to assess their own readiness to apply, especially if not having worked in the field of healthcare quality management for at least two years. A careful review of the examination content outline and the sample questions provided in the candidate handbook is advised.

What is covered in the certification test?

This is the only international voluntary healthcare quality management competency-based certification that tests knowledge in the following areas at all employment levels and in all healthcare settings:

- quality management
- quality improvement
- case/care/disease/utilization management
- risk management.

How much does it cost?

The fee for the computer-based domestic and international examination is **\$440**.

A discounted price is available to **NAHQ** (National Association for Healthcare Quality) members may take advantage of the **\$370 special NAHQ member fee**.

What is the procedure to follow for those interested in this certification?

1. The candidate's handbook is available at www.cphq.org/documents/HQCBhandbookJan09.pdf
2. Complete an application online at www.cphq.org
3. Pick a site to take the test which is given electronically

at over 170 approved sites at various geographical locations.

4. When the application has been approved, you will have 90 days to schedule and sit for the examination.
5. Take the exam at the site you selected.

What are the Benefits?

- Demonstration of knowledge and competency in the healthcare quality management field (for example - proof of competency to Joint Commission)
- Monetary incentive to complete certifications (offered by some organizations)
- Reimbursement for certification costs (offered by some organizations unless it is not achieved)
- Nationally a move to require this certification for anyone working in the field of healthcare quality management
- Personal satisfaction and achievement of professional goals

How do I maintain certification once it is achieved?

Recertification is required every 2 years. Each CPHQ can log continuing education hours online at www.cphq.org/2reCertification.html. Thirty continuing education hours are required.

Our challenge?

Mississippi did not have any new CPHQ certifications awarded in 2008 or 2009. The surrounding states, Louisiana, Tennessee, and Arkansas, all had persons achieving this certification. In fact, 52 persons from outside the United States were certified as well. Currently 28% of the MsAHQ members have achieved this certification!

Good news?

Most CPHQ review courses cost significantly more (up to 8 times more) than the upcoming review offered by MsAHQ and ADN. The CPHQ program is fully accredited by the National Commission for Certifying Agencies of the National Organization for Competency Assurance in Washington, D.C. It is the only international voluntary certification program in the field of healthcare quality management to achieve this accreditation
